Camp fee: \$80\* (8:30-3:30 pm) due no later than Monday March 25.

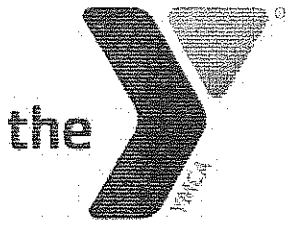

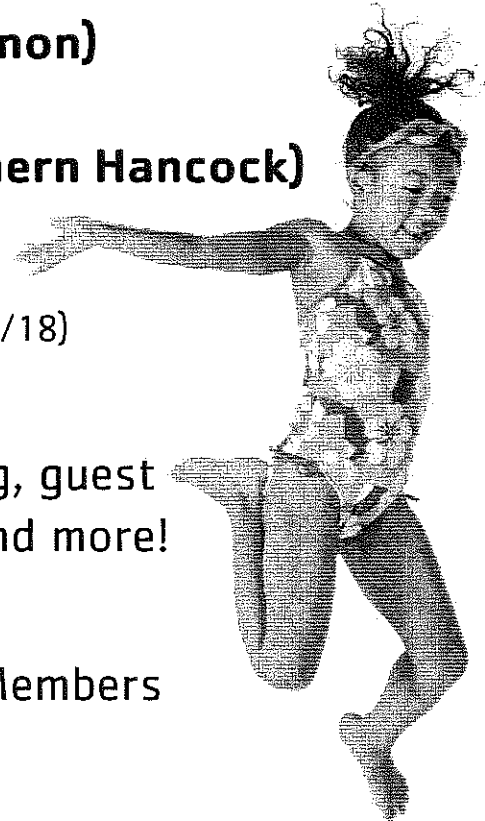
