


Welcome to Apple Week in Kindergarten® We are excited about our Apple Week! We have lots of activities planned® It is Go College Week and Fire Prevention Week.

Letters: Finish R, N, M, 1, 2

**If your child is left handed, they may "pull" the little lines towards or into the palm of their hand when forming letters like capital F, E, H.... ©

Everyday Math

This week in math we will be comparing & ordering numbers through 10 (this also includes ordinal numbers). We love playing the game, "I have (#), who has (Next #)?" Helpful tip: Draw a number line (0-10) on a scratch piece of paper. Leave one space blank (such as 7). Give clues using before and after. It comes before 8 and after 6. What is the number? (7) Write 7 in the blank space on the number line. Draw another number line and this time leave a different number missing—OR if you used pencil, you may erase a number and play the game again.

We will also learn about a new game called "monster squeeze" and we will measure with objects!
